

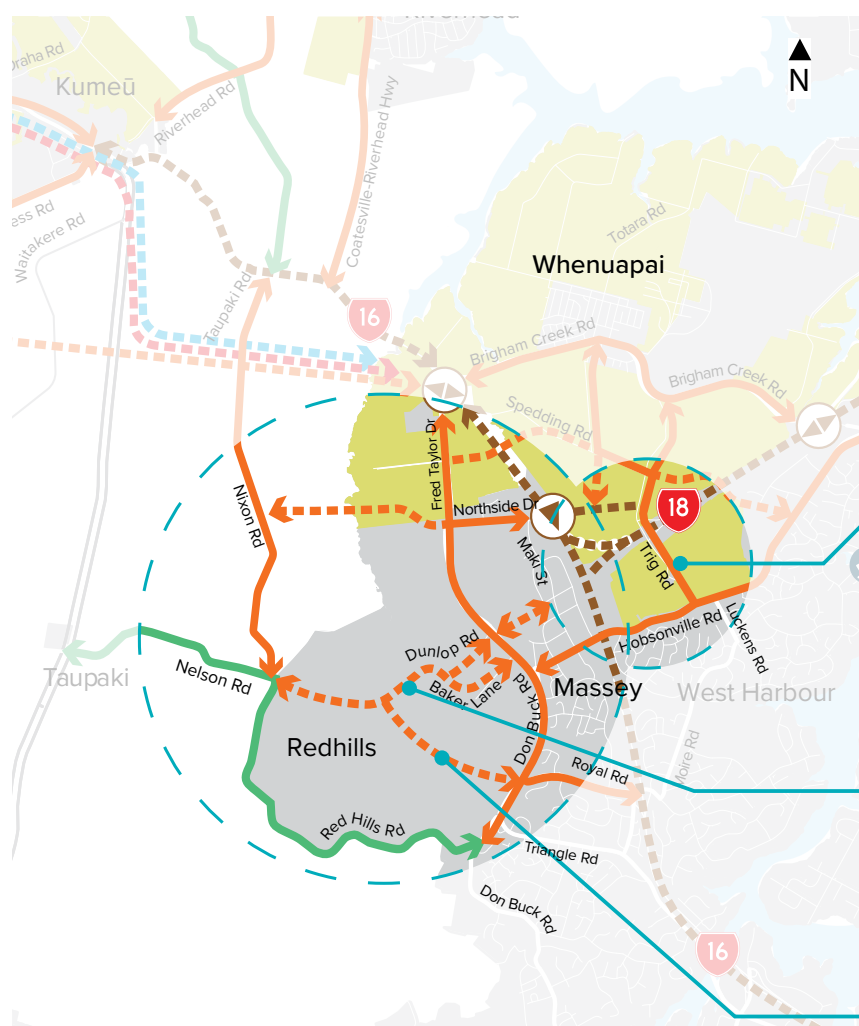
North West Route Protection

Progressing Key Connections in Whenuapai & Redhills

Three key transport connections are being progressed in Whenuapai and Redhills to support the increased growth and development being planned for these areas.

Right now we're working towards route protection for these connections, which means the land needed for these routes will be protected ahead of future construction, providing certainty to landowners and developers about where these connections will be located.

These are early projects from the wider Supporting Growth Programme. Other projects will be progressed in a staged way over the next few years.



Trig Road Upgrade Project

The upgrade of Trig Road south of SH18, through to Hobsonville Road, and the upgrade of the intersections of Trig and Luckens Roads with Hobsonville Road.

Redhills East-West Connections Project

New East-West arterial connection from Nixon and Nelson Roads to Fred Taylor Drive, including both Dunlop Road and Baker Lane.

Redhills North-South Connections Project

New North-South arterial connection from the new East-West connection to Royal and Don Buck Roads.
